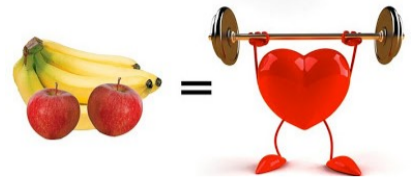

The 10c container deposit scheme has begun. Turn your empty, clean, eligible drink containers into cold hard cash. Like the FB page Containers for Change Moora Dalwallinu & Wongan Hills to keep up to date.

### How it works:

Save the eligible drink containers, “10c refund at collection depots/points in participating State/Territory of purchase” printed on the label. Wash them, de lid them, bag them, tag them, take to a collection depot, cash in

**Register your details** at Containersforchange.com.au and start cashing in. Community groups / clubs can also register as a recipient for fund raising. Limited cash— most **Payments will be electronic transfers.** Once you register, you receive a code to put on your bag - the cash value is transferred to the bank account you register. Bags will be given out at the schools, (one per family) or are available at Moora CRC for \$2 and can be swapped at the Tip.

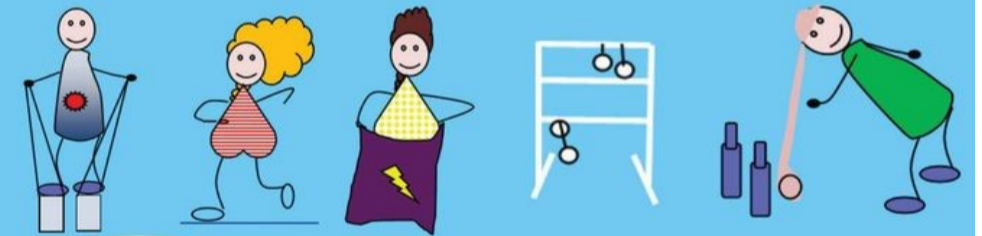
