

Travel restricted to Perth, Peel & South West.

Until Friday 5th February, (at this stage, 🙌 ,) you may only travel to these areas for essential services. You will need to apply for a G2G pass and show proof of travel requirement, (eg medical appointment letter) & id. If asked at a check point, please show the  letter or email to Police.

 Masks are mandatory outdoors, indoors, in / on public vehicles and at venues in these areas. Moora CRC can assist in applying for a G2G pass.

Interstate travel restrictions

Please check the state you are intending to travel to. In general, each state will require a pass or declaration form, testing on arrival and mandatory masks, in the airports and on planes. If travelling from a WA "hotspot" most states have mandatory 14 day quarantine & testing rules.

To return home, all WA residents are required to complete a G2G pass.

Next week Queensland and Victoria will transition to the very low risk category. Subject to no further outbreaks of COVID-19 this will take effect from:

- ◆ QLD - 12.01am Monday 1 February
- ◆ VIC - 12.01am Friday 5 February

From these dates, people arriving in WA who have been in QLD or VIC in the past 14 days will not be required to self-quarantine upon arrival but will be subject to strict conditions of entry.

All travellers arriving into WA are required to complete a G2G PASS registration and declaration. The following conditions of entry also apply:

- ◆ Travellers must wear a face mask on the airplane, and in the airport.
- ◆ Arrivals at Perth Airport will be subject to a health screening and temperature test.
- ◆ Travellers must be prepared to undertake a COVID-19 test at the airport if deemed necessary by a health clinician.
- ◆ Arrivals by land will be met at the border checkpoint for a health screening and to have their G2G PASS declaration checked.

QLD and VIC:



FROM TODAY, Tuesday 2nd February, additional businesses will be required to have a SafeWA QR Code or Manual register for patrons to sign in.

These include:

- Supermarkets / department stores / shopping centres
 - pharmacies
 - hardware stores
- takeaway food and beverage services
- retail components of businesses where customers are physically present such as bank branches
 - public & private hospitals (visitors only - persons visiting patients, or attending meetings/lectures, couriers, contractors)
 - events with a COVID Event Plan (500+ patrons), & certain outdoor functions and gatherings under 500 people (e.g. weddings, corporate functions, fetes, festivals).
- commercial buses or vessels that can carry 12 or more people where different groups of people interact including:
 - party buses / sightseeing tours
 - wine and food tour buses
 - hop on/hop off tour buses
 - party/function boats
 - sightseeing/tour boats
 - private charter buses/boats.
