

This Sunday will see the return of the ANZAC Day commemorations In conjunction with Moora RSL Sub Branch, Moora Lions Club, Rotary Club of Moora & Moora Community Resource Centre & Visitors Centre.

A number of COVID safe modifications have been made to the day, with the current State restrictions in place.

If you are attending an ANZAC Day service, you can stay COVID safe by;

- Scanning in using the SafeWA QR code or register on the contact register (you will be required to do this at each site throughout the day)
- Practicing physical distancing where possible
- Covering coughs / sneezes with a tissue or your elbow
- Washing your hands and using hand sanitiser (available on day)

## Three day lockdown for Perth & Peel

Temporary restrictions will apply until 12:01am Tuesday, 27 April, pending ongoing expert health advice.

### From 6:00pm today (23 April)



Masks will be mandatory for people aged 12 and over in Perth and Peel except:

- while at home
- during vigorous outdoor exercise
- while in a vehicle with members of your own household

Please use common sense. Exemptions apply, including for people with disabilities.

### From midnight tonight (12:01am Saturday 24 April)



Stay home except for these four reasons, or in an emergency situation:

- For work where it is not possible to work remotely
- For purchasing essential goods including food, groceries, medical or necessary supplies
- For one hour of outdoor exercise per day
- For medical or health care purposes, including looking after the vulnerable



**Regional boundary in place around Perth and Peel**  
Travel to other regions restricted to exempt reasons only.  
Anyone who has been in Perth or Peel since 17 April must wear a mask.

#### Other restrictions include:

- Private gatherings not permitted.
- Hospitality venues restricted to takeaway only.
- The following must close: fitness/recreational venues, casinos, nightclubs, entertainment venues, playgrounds, skate parks, outdoor recreational facilities, religious gatherings/ places of worship and cultural institutions.
- Visits to hospitals and aged/disability care are prohibited except for compassionate reasons.
- Community sport cancelled. Major sports events may proceed without crowds.
- ANZAC Day events cancelled. Driveway dawn services encouraged.
- Public events are not permitted.
- Weddings and funerals can proceed with up to 100 guests, but masks must be worn.

Further information will be provided in the coming days.

## Locations visited by confirmed COVID-19 cases

If you have been at any of the below locations at the times specified you need to attend a COVID clinic for testing and isolate at home until you receive a negative result.

Continue to monitor for symptoms for 14 days following your visit. If you experience any symptoms at any time – fever, coughing, shortness of breath, sore throat, runny nose, loss of smell or taste – go to a COVID clinic to be retested.

### Doctor Chapman Update

Information regarding Covid-19 virus in Moora 13/04/2021

We finally have some Astra Zeneca Covid 19 vaccines at the surgery. Our current allocation is 50 doses per week. Hopefully, that will increase as time goes on. We are starting the first weekly vaccination clinic tomorrow, 14/04/2021. Please call when you are ready and book in for a vaccine. Sorry, but because of the nature of the vaccines storage we need to administer them on this basis. Yes, it is the Astra Zeneca vaccine, Yes, there are some concerns about weird but rare blood clots with this vaccine. But it is a whole lot safer than contracting Covid 19. Currently the Astra Zeneca vaccine is licenced for use in those over 18 years old in Australia. However, with the current blood clot concerns the Health Department is recommending those under 50 consider if they need the vaccine now or should wait until the Pfizer vaccine becomes available. You can still have it if you are one of those young people, but we would recommend you discuss this with your GP first. No, I don't have a clue when we might have access to the Pfizer vaccine in Moora. I think it will probably happen some months down the track. The government hasn't had time to organize the logistics yet. Regarding Flu vaccines, we will be starting to immunize some business employee's next week, then onto everyone else in the weeks after that. Again, we plan to run Flu Vaccine "clinics" just to get everyone done. But these won't be so strictly controlled by vaccine numbers. Hope you enjoy our Medieval looking vaccination clinic! Well, that's how a certain Paramedic Trainee doing work experience with me described it today! I shall refrain from naming such person. Rustic is perhaps a better description, or original or unique or perhaps just cheap!! I was horrified to be questioned about the qualifications of the tradesman erecting our "Medieval" clinic, considering the nature of the construction materials.
