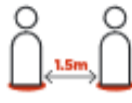

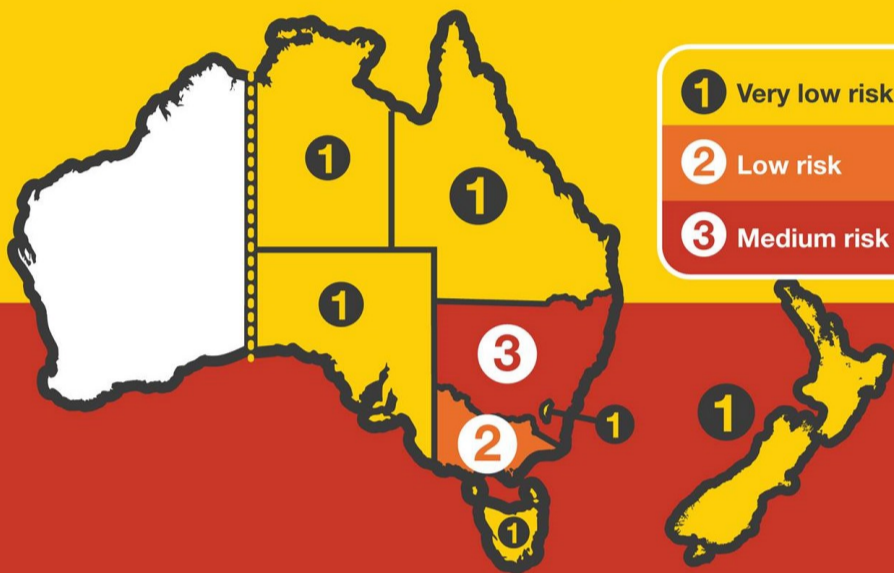

We're all in this together.

**New South Wales is now classified as a medium risk jurisdiction - effective 11:00am today, Wednesday 23 June**



**Under this change, hard border restrictions are in place for travellers who have been in NSW since 11 June or in the 14 days prior to travel.**

Only exempt travel will be permitted, and arrivals will be subject to 14 days self-quarantine and mandatory testing on arrival and on day 11.

From 6:00pm Friday, 11 June 2021, Victoria will be classified as a 'low risk' state following the latest health advice.

This means that anyone arriving from, or transiting through Victoria will be required to self-quarantine in a suitable premises for 14 days. All arrivals will also be subject to the following conditions of entry:

- Completed G2G PASS registration and declaration
- Health screening upon arrival at the airport or land border
- Must be prepared to take a COVID-19 test at the airport COVID clinic, if deemed necessary by a health clinician (voluntary asymptomatic testing available for all airport arrivals)
- Must present for a COVID-19 test on day 11

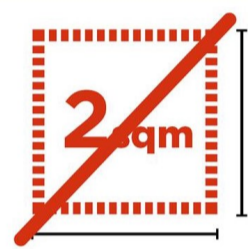
Travellers should download the G2G Now app prior to arriving in WA to allow for digital quarantine checks during their 14 day quarantine period.

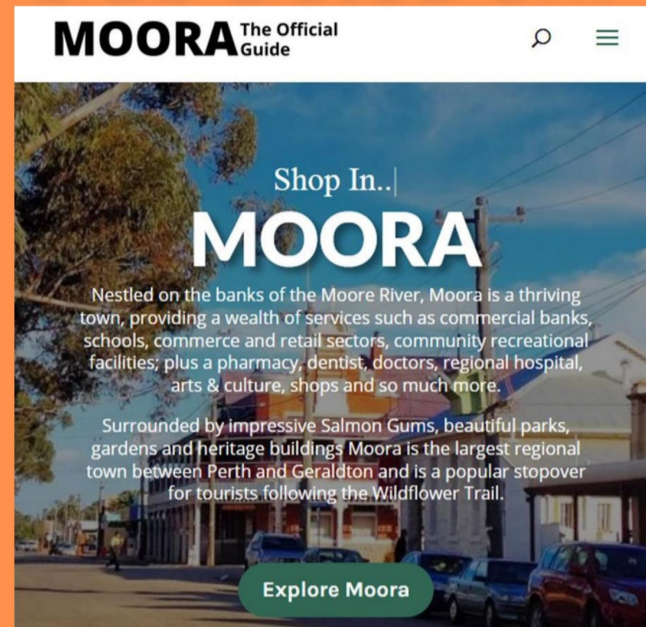
