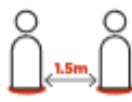

The Northern Territory is set to be classified as a 'very low risk' jurisdiction effective 12:01am Monday 12 July



Under this change, travel from the NT will be allowed without an exemption or requiring 14 days quarantine on arrival.

Arrivals will be required to complete a G2G Pass and undergo a health screening on arrival.

Great news: from midnight tonight, WA will return directly to pre-lockdown conditions.

This means no more masks, no capacity or crowd limits, no service restrictions, no limits on hospital or aged care visits and the return of dancefloors, major events and standing crowds at live performances.

As we move forward, it's important we all remain vigilant - but the past two weeks have once again shown the strength of our community.

- Complete all sections of the application form.
- Email wachs-wheatbelt_aboriginalhealthservice@health.wa.gov.au with the completed application form at least four weeks prior to starting your event(s) or program.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- You cannot accept funding from tobacco companies.
- Program(s) / event(s) cannot be part of core school curriculum.
- You cannot use funding for capital works, infrastructure, or other running costs.
- Program(s) / event(s) must occur in Western Australia.
- Funding cannot be used to advance or promote a religion or political party.
- You must have a current ABN or 'Statement of Supplier' form.
- You require current Public Liability Insurance.
