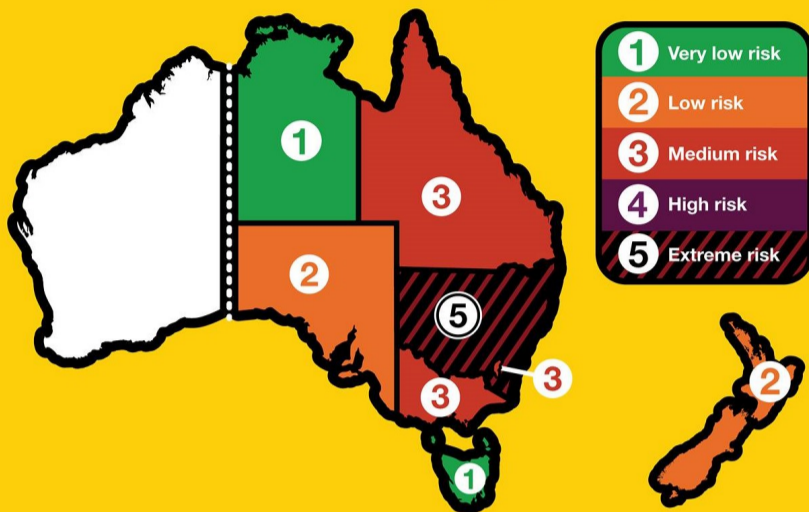

5 Extreme risk

Under the 'extreme risk' classification, exemption categories will be significantly tightened, limited to specific official functions and extraordinary circumstances.

In addition to the existing requirements for travel for a 'high risk' jurisdiction, approved travellers will be required to be tested for COVID-19 on days 1, 5 and 12, and undertake their 14 days quarantine in a State quarantine hotel at their own expense, unless otherwise advised.

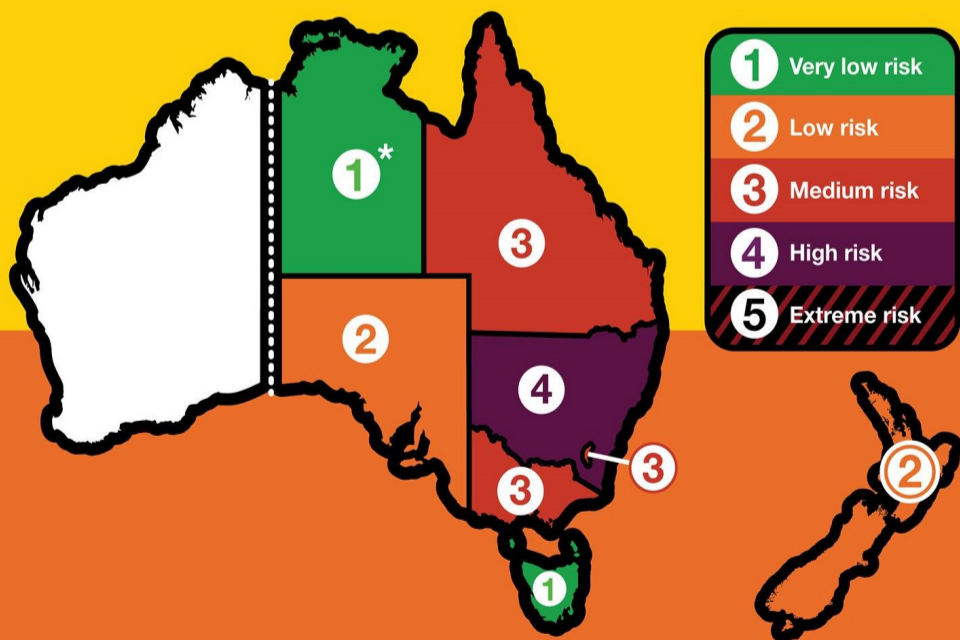
Information for Western Australians seeking to return from NSW

Any Western Australians currently in NSW and seeking to return should act now.

Under the current 'high risk' classification, Western Australians who left WA this year can apply to return, provided that they have received at least one dose of a COVID-19 vaccine (if eligible), return a negative test result prior to travel, and comply with the relevant quarantine and testing conditions upon arrival.

Please note that the 72 hour window for pre-travel test results has been lifted to assist those looking to return prior to the change of classification. Those looking to return in the coming days should seek a COVID-19 test as soon as possible.

New Zealand will be classified as a 'low risk' jurisdiction effective from noon today, 12:00pm Wednesday 18 August



Under this change, travellers to WA from New Zealand will be subject to 14 days self-quarantine and mandatory testing

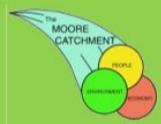
