


### Kindy to Year 6



# Upcoming changes for SA, QLD and NZ effective 12.01am, Thursday 26 August



## South Australia

Effective 12:01am Thursday 26 August

**South Australia will be classified as very low risk.**

Under this classification, travel from SA will be permitted without requiring quarantine on arrival. Arrivals will be required to complete a G2G Pass and undergo a health screening on arrival.



## New Zealand

Effective 12:01am Thursday 26 August

**New Zealand will be classified as medium risk.**

This classification returns WA to a hard border arrangement with NZ. Travel to WA from NZ will require an exemption, and those who travel will be required to undergo 14 days of self-quarantine and COVID-19 testing.



## Queensland

Effective 12:01am Thursday 26 August

**Queensland will be classified as low risk.**

Under this classification, travellers will no longer require an exemption. However, those who travel will still be required to undergo 14 days of self-quarantine and COVID-19 testing.



## New South Wales

Effective 12:01am Thursday 26 August

**As announced last week, New South Wales will be classified as extreme risk from midnight tonight.**

Under this classification, exemption categories will be significantly tightened. Those who are approved to travel will be required to enter hotel quarantine for 14 days and undergo three mandatory COVID-19 tests, in addition to requirements under 'high risk'.


