Existing strict exemption, self-quarantine and testing requirements remain. Those who are approved to travel will also be required to have received at least one vaccine dose (if eligible), provide proof of a negative test within 72 hours prior to departure, and use the G2G Now app while in quarantine.

Note: Effective 12.01am Monday, September 6, approved travellers from medium risk jurisdictions, aged 12 and older, are required to undertake a pre-travel COVID-19 test 72 hours prior to departure.



! Important information for recent arrivals from South Australia
 Public health advice has been issued for recently returned travellers into WA from South Australia.

Anyone who has been at the exposure sites at the specified times is required to:


- Self-quarantine at a suitable premises for 14 days from date of exposure
- Be tested within 48 hours and on day 12
- Wear a mask when transiting to a self-quarantine premises and presenting for COVID-19 testing.

Anyone who has not been at the listed sites during the specified times is advised to get tested if they develop any symptoms that may be related to COVID-19.

Short Course



This nationally accredited training is essential for all primary producers who use chemicals.

To enrol and complete this training participants need to have English reading and writing competency and provide a Unique Student Identifier (USI) number. USI can be obtained by applying via the following website: www.usi.gov.au

Risk Management in Pesticide Use (2 Day Basic Course)

This course is for those who need to acquire their AusChem accreditation.

Topics covered in the industry standard course includes:

- Training in safe and effective chemical use in the grower's industry
- Best practice for selecting, handling and applying chemicals for control weeds and pests.


