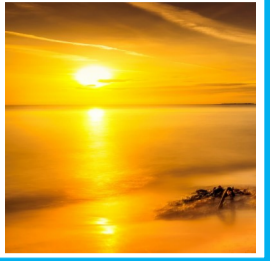

## Mandatory COVID-19 vaccinations

To protect WA and safeguard essential services and businesses for the long-term



### Occupations in which risk is sufficient due to high transmission, vulnerability or necessary to avoid catastrophic risk to safety of the community

#### Mandates with various implementation dates

- Hotel quarantine
- Ports (exposed workers only)
- Residential aged care
- Mission critical areas in WA Police
- Public and private hospitals and public healthcare facilities
- Cross-border freight (road and rail) workers - high and extreme risk locations only
- Primary and community health
- Onsite resources sector

The relevant vaccination requirements are largely covered by current public health directions/employers directions and these continue to apply.

#### First dose by 1 December 2021 and fully vaccinated by 31 December 2021

- Border and air transport
- Remaining residential and non-residential community care services not captured by previous mandates including in relation to:
  - Disability
  - In home and community aged care workers
  - Drug and alcohol services
  - Child protection
  - Homelessness
  - Family and domestic violence
  - Aboriginal peoples
- Corrective services
- Remaining WA Police
- Fire and Emergency Services (excluding volunteers)
- Abattoirs and meat processing



### Occupations deemed critical to the ongoing delivery of business and function of the community

#### First dose by 31 December 2021 and fully vaccinated by 31 January 2022

- Supermarkets, grocery, bakery
- Restaurant, pub, bar or café
- Post office
- Hardware store
- Child care or family day care
- School or boarding school\*
- TAFE and colleges of vocational education
- Financial institution
- Critical infrastructure and services necessary for health, safety and welfare of the community, any person, animal or premises e.g. utilities and veterinary clinic
- Petrol station, truck stops and roadhouses
- Public and commercial transport
- Remaining port operations
- Remaining commercial transport, freight or logistics
- Hotel, motel or other accommodation facility to provide accommodation services
- Funeral or mortuary services
- Building, maintenance or construction
- Staff working in or entering remote Aboriginal communities

\*(before Term 1 of the 2022 school year)



### In the event of a lockdown:

#### The following will be required to be fully vaccinated to attend work in the event of a lockdown or similar restrictions

- Other click and collect retail
- Bottle shop
- Newsagent
- Pet store
- Wholesaler
- Critical conveyancing and settlement agents
- Government or local government services where working from home is not possible
- Some administrative services
- Vehicle and mechanical repair service
- Journalistic and media services
- Members and staff of Members of Parliament of Western Australia
- Roadside assistance
- Critical forestry
- Critical primary industries
- Critical factories, manufacturing, fabrication and production

To get vaccinated go to [www.rollupforwa.com.au](http://www.rollupforwa.com.au) If an occupation fits in more than one category, the vaccination requirement with the earliest deadline should apply.

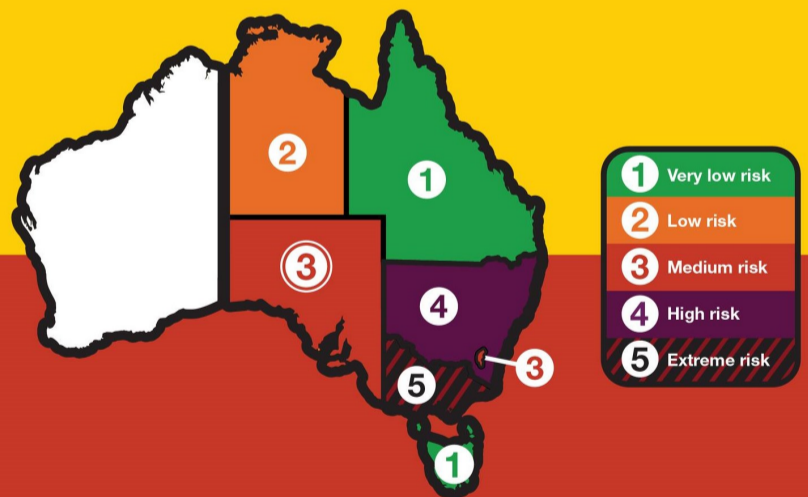

### WA Controlled Border Update

South Australia has been classified as a 'medium' risk jurisdiction, effective 12:01am tomorrow (Friday, 3 December)



Under this classification our hard border arrangement returns with South Australia. Travel to WA from South Australia will require an exemption, and those who travel are required to be double dose vaccinated, undergo 14 days self-quarantine and be tested for COVID-19.

### Information for recent travellers from South Australia

Anyone who has been to a close or casual contact exposure site during the relevant times is required to get tested immediately and self-quarantine for 14 days and have day 12 testing.

Anyone who has been at a low-risk casual contact exposure location should monitor their health and get tested if they develop any symptoms of COVID-19.

NOTE: Please be aware that Adelaide Airport is subject to multiple exposure times, locations and risk classifications. Read the website closely to determine which applies to you.
