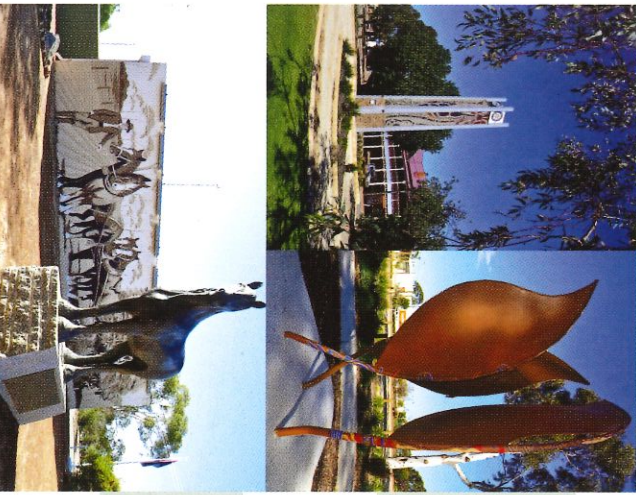

Local Attractions

CARNABY COCKATOO WALKING TRAIL
 This interpretive walk trail meanders along the Moore river bank through Moora. It is a staged project that once completed will play a major role in educating people about the conservation of the Carnaby's Cockatoo. Stages 1 - 3 are completed with the trail currently a flat and easy 3.5km (one way).

MOORA TOWN CLOCK
 The clock was designed by local school students with the design then translated and constructed into a magnificent stained glass feature by local artists.

MOORA TOWN WALK
 This fascinating walk is designed to give the visitor a taste of Moora. The walk features historical buildings, galleries, outdoor art and points of interest, including the Moora Town Clock.

MURALS
 Moora is on the Painted Road. There are several murals in Moora relating to specific historic, regional and future events.
